TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The regular scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Turtlecreek Township was held on September 10, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. with the following person present:

TRUSTEES: Jonathan D. Sams, Jim VanDeGrift, and Dan Jones.

CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER: Tammy Boggs

GUEST: Steve Flint, Mike Jameson, Erin Monroe, and Larry Wilson.

The meeting opened with Mr. Sams leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meeting were received by the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. There were corrections made to the minutes regarding the Resolution for the sidewalks. The minutes will be corrected and presented to the Trustees prior to the next meeting.

The Fiscal Officer notified the Trustees that the financial reports for the previous month were available for their review. By motion of Mr. VanDeGrift and seconded by Mr. Jones the following reports were approved. Cash Summary by Fund (month to date and year to date), Fund Status Report, and Bank Reconciliation for the previous month.

Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to accept the amounts and rates as determined by the Warren County Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor. Mr. Jones seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-09-01.** (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to proceed with the Moving Ohio Forward Grant. Mr. Jones seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-09-04**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

The Trustees discussed the fees in regards to the JEDD/TIF agreement with Bricker & Eckler. Mr. Jones made a motion to cover the fees up to \$15,000.00 for the I71/123 JEDD/TIF to Bricker & Eckler. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-09-03.** (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

Ms. Boggs, Fiscal Officer, informed the Trustees that the invoice from the Warren County Engineer's Office was received in the amount of \$58.306.46.

A letter was received from Warren County Regional Planning regarding the Estates of Keever Creek Section 1 Phase 1C. The Trustees have no comments or concerns regarding this site plan. A letter will be sent to the Warren County Regional Planning stating this information.

A letter was received from Warren County Regional Planning regarding Shaker Run Section Four, Phase F record plat. The Trustees have no comments or concerns regarding this plat. A letter will be sent to the Warren County Regional Planning stating this information.

Department Reports:

Fire/EMS: Steve Flint, Fire Chief, Mike Jameson, Assistant Fire Chief, and Erin Monroe, EMS Chief reported fire and EMS incident information. Chief Flint requested the purchase of replacement hose for the fire department at the approximate cost of \$3,190.00 from Warren Fire Equipment. Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to purchase the hose. Mr. Jones seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with Resolution 12-09-07. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes). Chief Flint requested the purchase of two (2) air packs at the approximate cost of \$10,514.00 from Vogelpohl. Mr. Jones made a motion to purchase the air packs. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-09-02**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes). Chief Flint requested that Mitch Conway be hired as a part time weekend EMT effective September 8, 2012 at a rate of \$9.50 per hour. Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to hire Mitch Conway. Mr. Jones seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with Resolution 12-09-06. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes). Assistant Chief Jameson requested the purchase of an inverter to add to the squad at an approximate cost of \$1,300.00. Mr. Jones made a motion to purchase the inverter. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed.

Road and Bridge: Larry Wilson, Road Supervisor, presented his weekly department activity reports completed since the previous meeting. Mr. Wilson discussed with the Trustees the quotes that he received to resurface the parking lot at the cemetery. The quote from Affordable Paving was \$6,500.00. Mr. Jones made a motion to have the parking lot at the cemetery resurfaced from Affordable Paving at the cost of \$6,500.00. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-09-04**. (A copy of the resolution in included in the minutes). Mr. Wilson informed the Trustees that the City of Lebanon will be closing Oregonia Road for 10 days to complete construction.
