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Work Session To Review Township Roads For Improvements & Repairs for the Future

A work session was held on Friday, May 2, 2014 at 7:00 AM with the following persons present:

TRUSTEES: Daniel Jones and Jim VanDeGrift ROAD SUPERVISOR: Larry Wilson

The session was called to order at 7:00 AM with the Pledge of Allegiance. The group then left to tour township roads with Mr. Wilson. The following roads were viewed, with commentary noted: **Mulford Road to**

Charleston Woods – 3-4 soft spots need to be addressed before we accept subdivision **Monroe Rd to view Old Orchard Lane**-surface 2-3 years old, mat and cape slurry with a lot of cracks visible, but nice surface. Cost \$5.25 - \$6.00/sq. for crack seal. However, according to Larry, you must wait 1 year after crack seal before you can slurry, and then would show need for new crack seal application. What is the answer to this problem?

Nickel Rd- okay, was chip/sealed in 2000

Keever Rd- chip/sealed in 2013, some gravel on road, but see no need to rent a sweeper machine/service – just need to make sure intersections are kept clean.

Tumbleweed- must determine road width and exact right-of-way. If we are not allowed on private property, are we mowing roadsides past our legal right-of-way?

Heritage Run-off Hatfield – has drainage problem. Many cracks which need grinding or thermo-patch (preferred) – need to investigate.

Liberty-Keuter, Settlemire, and Turtlecreek Union- had recent berming. Turtlecreek Union to have culvert work, which cost we will share one-half with Union Township. **Cook Rd** – no comments.

Group returned to township building. Jim VanDeGrift made motion to adjourn, Dan Jones seconded, and meeting was adjourned at 9:35 AM.
