TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

ON APRIL 28 15

The regular rescheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Turtlecreek Township was held on April 28, 2015 at 8:00 a.m. with the following person present:

TRUSTEES: Jonathan D. Sams, Dan Jones, and Jim VanDeGrift

CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER: Tammy Boggs

GUEST: Steve Flint, Michael Jameson, Ron Chasteen, JP Campbell, Michael Shaffer, Nick

The meeting opened with Mr. Sams leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meeting were received by the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Since there were no additions or corrections, Mr. Jones moved for acceptance, seconded by Mr. VanDeGrift. All were in favor and the minutes were approved as written.

The Trustees decided to donate the 6 Dell towers, 7 keyboards, 6 Mouse's and 1 Compaq monitor to the Warren County Trail Blazers for their scape metal drive.

Ms. Boggs informed the Trustees that the renewal for the Public Entity Insurance is \$6,407.00 for 2015. This is an increase from 2014 of \$491.00. Mr. Jones made a motion to renew the insurance policy. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed.

Mr. Sams informed the Trustees that at this time Pilot Travel Center will be using a package treatment plant instead of the city running the sewers to I71/123. The cost for the sewers came in much higher than originally expected.

The Warren County Regional Planning presented the Trustees with the amended condition 8 for Pilot Travel Center. The Trustees discussed this issue and have no comments or concerns at this time. A letter will be sent to Warren County Regional Planning stating this information.

The Township received notice from Warren County Health District that it is time for the backflow testing. Chief Flint will follow up on this item.

Enterprise Products has requested the use of the township's meeting room on May 21st. The Trustees approve the use of the room for Enterprise Products.

Mr. Jones discussed the TIF for Union Village and if additional legal counsel is necessary. A motion was made by Mr. Jones that we contact Ms. Brenda Wehmer, Peck, Shaffer & Williams, for additional representation. Mr. Jones made a motion for the legal services not to exceed \$5,000.00. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 15-04-06**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

Mr. Sams informed the Trustees that at the May 11, 2015 meeting a scholarship will be presented by the Warren County Township Association.

Mr. Nicholas J. Selhorst, Choice One Engineering, presented information regarding his company and the services that they can provide to the township.

Department Reports:

Fire/EMS: Steve Flint, Fire Chief and Mike Jameson, Assistant Fire Chief reported fire and EMS incident information. Assistant Chief Jameson signed the contract with Medicount for EMS billing serviced. Chief Flint notified the Trustees that the fire extinguishers at the Stations needed to be services. Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to service the fire extinguishers at the approximate cost of \$1,000.00 with MegaCity Fire Security. Mr. Jones seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with Resolution 15-04-05. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes). Chief Flint informed the Trustees that there will be a disc golf tournament Memorial Day weekend at the township park. They are expecting 200 plus players. Assistant Chief Jameson reported that the "V" box on the Road Department is in need of repairs. The approximate cost will be \$4,150.00 to sand blast and repaint. This matter was continued until the next meeting. Lt. JP Campbell requested the purchase of new brackets for the Life Pak's in the squads. The approximate cost will be \$3,000.00 from TMS Medical. This cost will be reimbursed by the State EMS grant. Mr. Jones made the motion to purchase the brackets. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with Resolution 15-04-02. (A copy of the resolutions is included in the minutes). Lt. Campbell also requested the purchase of a video display camera and sked base rescue system, which will also be reimbursed from the grant. The video camera's approximate cost is \$1,289.99 from Bound Tree and the sked base rescue approximate cost is \$736.56 from CMC. Mr. Jones made a motion to purchase the video camera and sked base rescue. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the

motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motions were passed with **Resolution 15-04-03 and 15-04-04.** (A copy of the resolutions is included in the minutes).

Road and Bridge: Ron Chasteen, Road Crew Chief, presented his weekly department activity reports completed since the previous meeting. Mr. Chasteen received the approval from the Trustees to post a seasonal position with the pay range of \$9.00 - \$10.50 per hour. Mr. Chasteen informed the Trustees that the Warren County Engineer's office will be repairing the black top on Golden Rod, Trails of Shaker Run Section 6. Mr. Chasteen will be sending a letter to the county engineer's office to request 900 tons of salt for the 2015-2016 season. Mr. Chasteen requested that a no outlet sign be placed on Barton Lane. Mr. Chasteen discussed the debris on the property line between the church and the school. He will follow up with the church. Mr. Jones made a motion to promote Mr. Chasteen to Road Supervisor effective May 2, 2015. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed. Mr. Chasteen informed the Trustees that he is meeting with the engineer's office on April 30, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. regarding the exception of Shaker Run Section One Phase C.
