#### **TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

ON **SEPTEMBER 27** 16

The regular scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Turtlecreek Township was held on September 27, 2016 at 8:00 a.m. with the following person present:

The meeting opened with Mr. VanDeGrift leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meeting on 9/12/2016 were received by the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Since there were no additions or corrections, Mr. Jones moved for acceptance, seconded by Mr. Sams. All were in favor and the minutes were approved as written.

Department Reports:

#### Fire/EMS:

Steve Flint, Fire Chief, informed the board that M33 was at Warren County Diesel for an emergency repair of a High Pressure Oil Pump. Approximate cost of the repair at this time is \$2,380.00. Mr. Sams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jones to approve for the needed cost of the squad repair. All present voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion passed with resolution 16-09-05 (a copy of the resolution will be included in the minutes).

Mike Jameson, Assistant Chief, informed the board that several department members had just completed a great training on trench rescue. A total of 6 members went through the training with most earning a technician level certification in the course.

Road and Bridge: Ron Chasteen, Road Supervisor, informed the board that the Road Dept. was pretty caught up on mowing. Mr. Chasteen requested for approval to purchase an additional 2 skids of crack sealer from DJL at a cost of \$1,013.75 each. Mr. Jones made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sams to approve for the purchase of 2 additional skids of crack sealer for a total amount of \$2,027.50. All present voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion passed with resolution 16-09-06 (a copy of the resolution will be included in the minutes).

#### Administration:

Tammy Boggs, Township Administrator, informed the board that the Warren County Board of Zoning Appeals had received a Zoning Appeal request from Ann Philippo and the board was asking if the township had any comments or concerns. The trustees do not have any comments or concerns at this time on the zoning variance. A letter will be sent to Warren County Zoning stating this information.

Mrs. Boggs asked the trustees if they would like to discuss access to the facility. The board discussed creating a policy to restrict personal use of the building and its equipment to personnel and their direct family members. Mrs. Boggs informed the board she had spoken with Bruce McGary with the prosecutor's office and with our liability carrier and they advised that liability waivers should be signed if we are going to allow personnel other than those employed by the township to use its building and equipment. The board declined to make a motion on any policy at this time and will continue this issue for further review.

## **Fiscal Officer Reports:**

Mr. Johnson informed the board that the Warren County Budget Commission had approved the townships budget and returned the levy amounts for the 2017 tax year. A resolution will be required to accept the rates of the levies of the budget commission. Mr. Sams made a motion, followed by Mr. Jones to accept the levy rates for the 2017 tax year. All present voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion passed with resolution 16-09-04 (a copy of the resolution will be included in the minutes).
