TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

ON **OCTOBER 25** 16

The regular scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Turtlecreek Township was held on October 25, 2016 at 8:00 a.m. with the following person present:

The meeting opened with Mr. VanDeGrift leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meeting on 10/10/2016 were received by the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Since there were no additions or corrections, Mr. Jones moved for acceptance, seconded by Mr. VanDeGrift. All were in favor and the minutes were approved as written.

Department Reports:

Fire/EMS:

Steve Flint, Fire Chief, informed the board that they only received one application for the two part time EMS position openings. Chief Flint recommended the part time hiring of EMT-B Shelby Dye at a rate of \$12.50 effective 11/6/2016. Mr. Sams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jones to approve the part time hire of Shelby Dye as an EMT at \$12.50 per hour effective 11/6/2016. All present voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion passed with Resolution 16-10-04 (a copy of the resolution will be included in the minutes).

Road and Bridge: Ron Chasteen, Road Supervisor, informed the board that the Road Dept. was pretty caught up on mowing and had some more crack sealing to do. Mr. Chasteen also mentioned he would be reviewing section 4a of Shaker Run and Section 8 of The Trails of Shaker Run with the Engineers Office in the upcoming days for acceptance.

Mr. Chasteen informed the board that there was an emergency repair needing done on the Boom Mower and that Walt Luti was performing the repair at a cost of \$1,071.00. Mr. Jones made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sams to approve for the emergency repair from Walt Luti for the mower. All present voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion passed with resolution 16-10-05 (a copy of the resolution will be included in the minutes).

Lastly, Mr. Chasteen informed the board that he would like to contract with Contract Sweepers and Equipment to street sweep the townships curb & gutter style subdivisions using funds of the \$7,500.00 allowance provided by Warren County. The cost of 3 street sweeps using Contract Sweepers and Equipment will be \$2,200.00. Mr. Sams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jones to approve for the purchase of street sweeping services at a cost of \$2,200.00 reimbursable by Warren County. All present voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion passed with resolution 16-10-06 (a copy of the resolution will be included in the minutes).

Administration:

Tammy Boggs, Township Administrator, informed the board that a letter had been received regarding the Warren County Township Association Annual Dinner on 11/10/2016 at 6 P.M. The board was asked to make notice to Jenny if they were planning to attend so the proper reservations could be made.

Mrs. Boggs informed the board that the Township will be hosting a speaker regarding training on evaluations and Job Descriptions on November 21st, 2016. The cost to the township will be \$350.00. Mrs. Boggs will also be inviting other department heads from entities across Warren County to participate at a cost of \$15.00 per person attending.

Mrs. Boggs informed the board that a member of the Fire Department had requested to be able to publish a newsletter on the township's website each quarter. Mr. Sams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jones to approve for the publishing of the newsletter on the township's website provided they are able to approve each newsletter prior to posting. All present voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion passed.

Mrs. Boggs informed the board that she had received a quote from Beth Gulley to contract on visual design services to help brand the township at an initial cost of \$3,500.00. The initial fee would allow Beth to begin with branding fonts and scripts. The trustees made no motion on the matter and requested time to think about how they would like to move forward.

Fiscal Officer Reports:

Mr. Johnson informed the board that the townships www.ohiocheckbook.com site was ready to be published and displayed the website content on the projector screen for the board to review. No additions or request for noted so Mr. Johnson will be contacting the State Treasurer's Office to make the site available to the public.

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATIONS TO ESTABLISH A REASONABLE AND SAFE SPEED LIMIT ON N. WAYNESVILLE ROAD BETWEEN WILMINGTON ROAD AND OREGONIA ROAD

WHEREAS, a request has been made to this Board of Trustees that the statutory vehicular speed limit established by Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 4511.21 is greater than that considered reasonable and safe on N. Waynesville Road,

WHEREAS, the Warren County Engineer has performed an engineering and traffic investigation upon the section of road described, and:

WHEREAS, it is the belief of this Board that such investigation confirms the allegation that the statutory speed limit of 55mph is unrealistic,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees, Turtlecreek Township that:

Section 1. By virtue of the provisions of Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 4511.21, the Director of Transportation is hereby requested to review the engineering and traffic investigation prepared by the Warren County Engineer and to determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit on N. Waynesville Road between Wilmington Road and Oregonia Road and;

Section 2. That when the Board is advised that the Director of Highways has determined and declared a reasonable and safe speed limit on the section of road described in Section 1 hereof, standard signs, properly posted and giving notices thereof, will be erected.

Mr. Jones moved to adopt the foregoing Resolution. Mr. Sams seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the Resolution was passed.
